Reminder of CLRG Social Media Policy

Rule 6.6 There should be no images of individual dancers, especially in costume, posted to social media in the lead up to competitive events. Any identifiers such as names of individual dancers, competitor's numbers, section information etc also must not be used in posts of any kind in the lead up to competitive events.

We would ask that you refrain from posting above items on your School/Business or Personal accounts be it Facebook, Website, Instagram, "X" (formerly Twitter), TikTok etc.

<u>As of NOW</u>, we would ask that you would not post any congratulatory and celebratory pictures of dancers competing at Oirechtas Rince na Mumhan 2023.

Please inform your dancing parents of this directive also.

Do not have your parents Tag you in any social media posts.

Consequences of Breaching this Policy

7.1. Non -compliance with this policy will be grounds for disciplinary action. Any breach of this policy may be defined as Gross Misconduct under Section 3.11 of the CLRG Code of Conduct and Disciplinary Procedure

Schools can use the Munster logo for Good Luck messages during the week of the Oireachtas.
